Dear Secretary General:

On behalf of IWUF President Mr. Gao Zhidan, I am writing to update you regarding the wushu competition of Dakar 2026 Youth Olympic Games (YOG). The IOC Executive Board decided recently in Lausanne to finalize the event program and the athlete quota for the YOG Dakar 2026.

The events and athlete quota for Dakar 2026 were reviewed based on recommendations from the Olympic Programme Commission and the new principles approved by the IOC Executive Board in June 2024. These principles aim to develop a programme that better aligns with the local and regional context, simplifies the Games delivery by tailoring the event programme to the updated venue master plan and facilities, and ensures consistency with youth development pathways, gender equality, and the overall credibility of the event.

In this context, the IOC has finalized the following YOG Dakar 2026 event programme for wushu:
